Goal 3

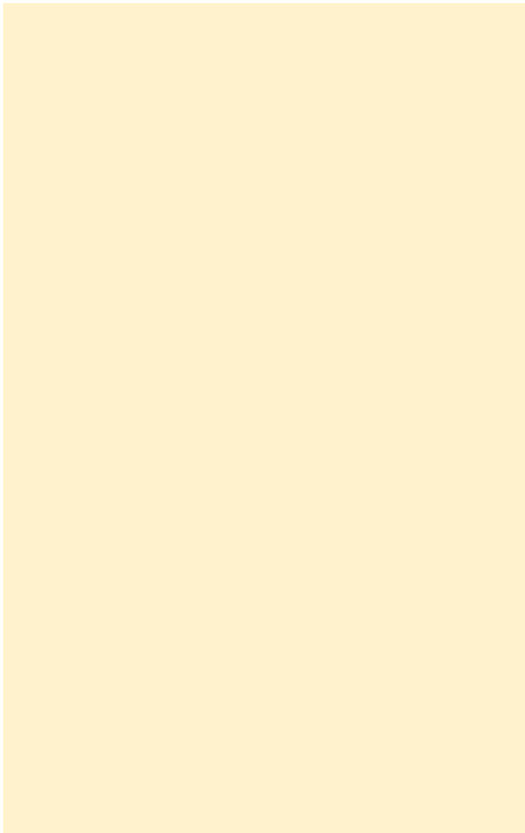
- English, math, and science are in the process of choosing RIDE approved curriculum
