School Improvement Plan

- Next year, with our NEASC visit, as a faculty, we need to identify our areas of priority and our areas of need. The new School Improvement Plan will be made from this work.

Part of measuring our school improvement plan progress is analyzing data and looking at goals compared to actions. Here is some information on our progress towards our goals.

- An area of need is the subgroup of Students with Disabilities

- We changed class structures to help with this
- With COVID, we know there is learning loss
- We have two new high-quality curriculums in math and English: Reveal Math and Study Sync
- PD Topics: ALICE, Legal, SEL, NEASC, Restorative Justice
- A new SEL coordinator was appointed with some COVID
- We brought in more CTE programs and ROTC
- Math RTI
- We no longer have the comp period for English, which offered remediation, but we did gain more electives and smaller class sizes.
- The Vision of the Graduate Articulation with Elementary and Middle Schools is currently in progress. What will the crest look like at other schools? Every school has different colors and mascots. Mike G. has some ideas to share with other schools. Christen will send out an anonymous survey.
- The Leadership Team is working on overhauling the schedule to give students more learning opportunities and courses. Students are having trouble being able to take multiple specialized classes due to the periods classes currently run.
